# “Revelation”: Absolute & Relative, Primary & Secondary

Sometime confusion arises with the use of “revelation,” both in the Scriptures themselves, and in the language of those who teach it.

The root of the “problem” is that the word “revelation” is commonly used in both an *absolute* and *relative* sense – with both a *primary* and a *secondary* meaning.

Our English word “revelation” can refer to that process by which God makes Himself and His plans known at-large, or *absolutely*, a process that results in “Scripture.” This is *primary* revelation.

However, “revelation” can also be used to refer to the *relative* act of God bringing about individual enlightenment, resulting in Him opening the Scriptures to one’s own personal understanding. This is a *secondary* revelation, founded on the *primary* revelation of Scripture.

The Scriptures themselves use the word “revelation” in both *absolute* and *relative, primary* and *secondary* ways as well. The Greek word for “revelation” is ἀποκάλυψις (*apokalupsis*), and simply means,

- disclosure (*SEC*);
- uncovering (*CL*);
- laying bare, making naked (*TGL*).

The Greek elements for “revelation” are,

FROM-COVERING (*CKC*).

For example, in the *absolute, primary* way, Paul declares,



for by **revelation** [*apokalupsis*] the secret is made known to me (Ephesians 3:3, CV).

Yet, in the *relative, secondary* way, Paul prayed,

that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may be giving you a spirit of wisdom and **revelation** [*apokalupsis*] in the realization of Him (Ephesians 1:17, CV).

So, we can see from these two verses that,

- (1) “revelation” (*apokalupsis*), in its *absolute* and *primary* way, as in the case of Ephesians 3:3, results in Scripture – Paul’s epistle of Ephesians.
- (2) “revelation” (*apokalupsis*), in its *relative* and *secondary* way, as in the case of Ephesians 1:17, results in an individual’s “realization.”

In fact, the diverseness of the Greek word *apokalupsis* is demonstrated even in the “Concordant” Version, as it is constrained to, as it does from time to time, become *dis-concordant*, translating the 18 occurrences of *apokalupsis* as:

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# Prophetic Gaps

## Key Points:

Students of prophecy who are ignorant of the important principle of prophetic gaps are extremely liable to serious error

in their prophetic understanding and interpretation. .... 7844

**A**n important principle in understanding the fulfillment of Hebrew Prophecy is that of *prophetic gaps*.

*filled in your ears*" (Luke 4:16-21, CV).

## A PROPHETIC COMMA

Luke chapter 6 provides a clear example of such a *prophetic gap*.

The passage that Jesus read was a prophecy from Isaiah 61. What is most notable about Jesus' reading of this passage is that He abruptly stopped reading the prophecy, mid-sentence, then rolled up the scroll and sat back down.

[Jesus] came to Nazareth, where He was reared, and, according to His custom on the day of the sabbaths, He entered into the synagogue and rose to read. And handed to Him was a scroll of the prophet Isaiah, and, opening the scroll, He found the place where it was written,

Needless to say, this was quite a strange experience to those present that day,

*And the eyes of all in the synagogue were looking intently at Him.*

*"The spirit of the Lord is on Me, on account of which He anoints Me to bring the evangel to the poor. He has commissioned Me to heal the crushed heart, to herald to captives a pardon, and to the blind the receiving of sight; to dispatch the oppressed with a pardon, to herald an acceptable year of the Lord ..."*

Christ responded by telling them that,


*Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your ears.*

*And furling the scroll, giving it back to the deputy, He is seated. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were looking intently at Him. Now He begins to be saying to them that "Today this Scripture is ful-*

It would pay one to read all eleven verses of Isaiah 61. All that Christ read were the first verse and a half. Then He suddenly stopped reading verse two before its end. He stopped at a comma.

Let's look at the first three verses of Isaiah 61. We will place the portion of the passage which Jesus read at the synagogue in bold type.

***The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me; because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He has sent Me to bind up the***

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**brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; to appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He might be glorified (Isaiah 61:1-3, CV).**

### JESUS RIGHTLY DIVIDED THE WORD OF TRUTH

Jesus divided the first portion of this passage from the rest, and told them,

**“Today THIS Scripture is fulfilled in your ears.”**


Our Lord Jesus Christ practiced right division that day.

He was fulfilling only the very first portion of Isaiah 61. If He had read past the comma of :2 He could not have made the statement, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your ears.”

### A COMMA OF THOUSANDS OF YEARS

Although no one else at the synagogue that day understood it, the coming and work of their Messiah was to be fulfilled in two distinct periods of time separated by thousands of years.

Jesus fulfilled Isaiah 61 *only* through the phrase “to herald an acceptable year of the Lord ...” The next phrase of that sentence, “and the day of vengeance of our God,” would still be thousands of years away. For in fact, even



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if the rest of this passage *could* begin to be fulfilled in our own day, there has already been a two-thousand-year gap in this one comma found in Isaiah 61:2. Such is the nature of prophetic passages.

We do not know how much more time will transpire before the rest of the verse and chapter of Isaiah are fulfilled. Yet, we submit to our readers that as much as another thousand years may remain, if not thousands more. God withstanding, no one knows how long it will be.

Thus, it is Christ Himself who introduces us to the important principle of *prophetic gaps*.

### A THOUSAND YEARS “AND”

Before closing, we will consider another quick example of the *prophetic gap*. This time the gap is represented by an “and.”

*Don't be amazed at this, for the hour is coming, when all who are in the graves will hear His voice, and will come out; those who have done good, unto the resurrection of life; **and** those who have done evil, unto the resurrection of judging (John 5:28-29).*

For centuries this verse was used as the basis and proof text for a *general resurrection*. The idea was that a single “hour” is coming when “all” – both “those who have done good” **and** “those who have done evil” – will be resurrected together. Yet such is not the case, and it is clearly revealed in progressive revelation that there are multiple resurrections ahead separated in one plain example by a thousand years.

*(The rest of the dead do not live until the thousand years should be finished.) This is the former resurrection (Revelation 20:5, CV).*

"revelation" 11 times, and  
"unveiling" 7 times.

However, to help alleviate confusion surrounding the word "revelation," it has long been my practice simply to limit my personal use of the word "revelation" to its *absolute, primary* sense, and to choose other words when dealing with the *relative, secondary* act of God in dealing with individuals. I use such words as:

enlightenment, illumination, insight, realization, comprehension, understanding, recognition, and awareness.

Some translations follow similar suit in their attempts at emphasizing the distinction between the *relative, secondary* meaning of *apokalupsis* as found in Ephesians 1:17. So, instead of translating it as "revelation," notice the other ways that it has been translated:

*That, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, would give you a Spirit of wisdom and **UNDERSTANDING** in gaining a personal knowledge of Him (REB).*

*That God, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ and*

This may have been a norm for Paul: he acquired new information from God that was "not lawful" (II Corinthians 12:4, KJV; i.e., "not allowed" (CV, HCSB, DAR) for him to make known at the time that he acquired it.

With the hindsight of Ephesians and Colossians we are able to see clearly from Philippians that Paul knew the secret, and was pressing forward towards the time of its permitted revelation. He was eager to "attain" and "apprehend" that for which he was "apprehended" – "pressing" toward it (Philippians 3:11-14). Thus, Philippians is the gateway to Ephesians and Colossians.

## Editor's Desk

### Sleep

All of us are different, in so many various ways. For me, sleep is one of these areas where my own uniqueness is evidenced.

Beginning in the mid-90s, regardless of what time I would go to bed, I would normally awake 3-4 hours later. For a few years I would battle this, as though it were some kind of curse. This is because I listened to the “8 hours a night” advice that is always offered.

I would lay in bed awake for hours every night trying to fall back asleep. After all, it was what I *should* do for my health. Staying in bed when I was awake, because I was *supposed* to, became a great prison to me.

After a while, I just learned to get up when I was awake. For the last 25 years or so, my sleep norm is 3-4 hours most nights – with perhaps an occasional 5-to-15-minute powernap somewhere in the late afternoon, or early evening. After multiple nights of this short sleep schedule, I will usually sleep 5-6 hours one night, occasionally longer, then right back to my norm.

What I had viewed in the beginning as a “curse,” I eventually came to see as my special “blessing.” I am usually up somewhere between 1:00-3:00 most mornings. I am up wide awake, and I aggressively begin my studies and writing. While others are asleep in the house it allows for many hours of very quiet productive time. Over time I have come to relish my early morning time. I would not be the person that I am today without my norm of 3-4 hours a night.

I sleep when I am sleepy, and am up working when I am awake, regardless of the advice of the experts. Interestingly, for me, on the nights that I get 3-4 hours of sleep I am usually the most awake and productive for the day. On the nights that I sleep longer, not only do I have less

working time, but I am more typically sluggish.

Thomas Edison wrote,

I never found need of more than four or five hours sleep in twenty-four hours. I never dream. It's real sleep. When by chance I have taken in more [sleep], I wake up dull and indolent [disinclined to work]).

Winston Churchill averaged 5-6 hours of sleep per day (which included a full-blown daily 2-hour nap during the day). “You get two days in one – well, at least one and a half.”

Leonardo De Vinci followed the “Uberman sleep cycle” – an extreme form of *polyphasic sleep* (or segmented sleep). This is the practice of sleeping multiple times in a 24-hour period. The Uberman method involves 20-minute naps every 4 hours – about 1-½ hours of sleep a day. Nikola Tesla followed this same sleep pattern.

I am well aware that my sleep patterns are not “normal,” and I *do not* recommend them. They are not something that I *try* to do, neither do I suggest anyone else *trying* them. Each of us are very uniquely made, and we must not fight the design of God for us.

Cf. “Some People Have a Superhuman Strength: Only Needing 4 Hours of Sleep,” Manasee Wagh, *Popular Mechanics*, June 27, 2022:

These “short sleepers” don't necessarily do it by choice – they're genetically programmed to require less. Short sleepers are people who do well with about half of the shut-eye that the rest of us require to function. Researchers have discovered particular mutations in three genes that control short sleepers' resting needs. Their super-efficient sleep helps maintain better health and greater resilience to stress.

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
