"The Complement of the Nations"

Romans 11:25

Key Points:

In Acts and Romans, while Jewish and Gentile believers were doctrinally equal in faith, Jews held a superior dispensational standing, with Gentiles being subservient......8435 The inclusion of Gentiles, symbolized by the olive tree in Romans 11, was initially to provoke Israel but they rejected Christ

Therefore, we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law. Is He the God of the **Jews** only? Is He not **also of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also:** seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith. (Romans 3:28-30).

The truth am I telling in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience testifying together with me in holy spirit, That my sorrow is great, and unintermittent pain is in my heart -- for I myself wished to be anathema from Christ -- for my brethren, my relatives according to the flesh, who are Israelites, whose is the sonship and the glory and the covenants and the legislation and the divine service and the promises; whose are the fathers, and out of whom is the Christ according to the flesh, Who is over all, God be blessed for the eons. Amen! (Romans 9:1-5).

In correctly partitioning God's Word of Truth, it is imperative to see that, in the Secret Administration as revealed in Ephesians and Colossians, we **DO NOT lose the DOCTRINAL standings** written in Romans that were true for ALL believers.

What was lost was the DISPENSATIONAL stand-

ings.¹ The believers from the nations who were grafted² into Israel were, in that era, subservient to the Jewish believer. In that dispensation the Jew was first.³ In fact, we should see that the DISPENSATIONAL change in standing from the Acts dispensation ("the Jew first") to our DISPENSATIONAL standing in the "YET NOW" Secret Administration is to our advantage.

During the dispensation when Romans was written, DOCTRINALLY speaking the Jew and Gentile be**liever were equal in spirit** [rather than in the flesh].

For there is **no difference** between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him (Romans 10:12).

Each were justified by faith apart from the law – in **spirit** [again, rather than in the flesh].

However, **DISPENSATIONALLY** speaking the Jew and Gentile believer were NOT equal in standing.

The grafting of the Gentile believer into Israel – before the nation was saved and ready for their "great commission" to ALL the Earth - was, as it states, "contrary to nature."

God's purpose in this graft was to provoke Israel to **jealousy**, but we know that that didn't happen. The nation forfeited its position because of unbelief, and Israel's failure resulted in the riches of the Gentiles.

In the Acts period, Israel's **DISPENSATIONAL** standing as a nation was a position of favor before God. Yet the individual Jew and Gentile who believed the Gospel had equal footing DOCTRINALLY.

"Yet NOW," in this present dispensation of Absolute Grace,8 we know that the favored nation lost its fa-

vorable standing when we read Acts 28:28.9

What happened to the believing Jews and the believing Gentiles (that we read about in **Romans 11**), when the unrepentant nation lost its favorable standing with God (Acts 28:28)?

In light of the olive tree illustration, what does it mean that "callousness, in part, on Israel has come, UN-TIL the complement of the nations may be entering"?

For I am not willing for you to be ignorant of this secret, brethren, lest you may be passing for prudent among yourselves, that callousness, in part, on Israel has come, until the complement of the nations may be entering. And thus all Israel shall be saved, according as it is written, "Arriving out of Zion shall be the Rescuer. He will be turning away irreverence from Jacob. And this is My covenant with them Whenever I should be eliminating their sins" (Romans 11:25-27, CV).

I believe that the above is the revealed will of God. Its purpose was that Israel would be provoked to emulation while the hope of Israel's salvation as a nation was still viable.

With the nation of Israel failing, God added believing Gentiles to partake of "the root and fatness." This very act of God was to provoke the nation to a zealous jealousy, i.e., that the nation would desire what right-

fully belonged to them. That didn't happen! In fact, Israel not only rejected Christ and the message, but also DID NOT want the Gentiles to hear and receive it. Remember the times they plotted to kill Paul?¹¹

A number from the nations were to be added ("the complement of the nations"), along with the believing Jews, as long as Israel's hope was still possible. When "the complement of the nations" reached its fullness, then ALL Israel was to be saved.

Acts 28:28 had NOT yet been written when Paul wrote Romans 11.

Like many things in God's Word, what we read is God's revealed will - that is, what would have transpired, as we see it written, IF Israel had repented. Yet God's hidden intention was that the nation would not repent, and thus the salvation of Israel as a nation did NOT happen as revealed.¹²

NO, it did NOT, because that which was revealed regarding Israel's hope (the Kingdom being restored and ALL Israel being saved), was placed in abeyance. So, too, ended Gentiles being added to the olive tree, because that DISPENSATION came to an end at Acts 28:28. What happened to those Gentile believers? We are told what happened to them in Ephesians.

In the Acts period, DISPENSATIONALLY speaking, Gentile believers were "far off."

Wherefore, remember that once you, the na-


tions in flesh - who are termed "Uncircumcision" by those termed "Circumcision" in flesh, made by hands - that you were, in that era [dispensationally speaking], apart from Christ, being alienated from the citizenship of Israel, and guests of the promise covenants, having no expectation, and without God in the world (Ephesians 2:11-12, CV).

That was the **DISPENSATIONAL** standing of the Uncircumcised Gentile believer in Romans 11. It was NOT their DOCTRINAL standing.

Yet NOW, in Christ Jesus [in this dispensation of Absolute Grace], you [believing Gentiles], who once are far off [dispensationally], are become near by the blood of Christ. For He is our Peace, Who makes both one, and razes [destroys] the central wall of the barrier (the enmity in His flesh), nullifying the law of precepts in decrees, that He should be creating the two, in Himself, into one new humanity, making peace; and should be reconciling both in one body to God through the cross, killing the enmity in it. And, coming, He brings the evangel of peace to you, those afar, and peace to those near, for through Him we both have had the access, in one spirit, to the Father (:13-18).

The Romans 11:25 "complement of the nations" quantification¹³ was a DISPENSATIONAL truth as long as God was adding Gentiles to the olive tree. Yet with Israel's final rejection, as recorded in Acts 28:28, NO longer was there a place for the Gentile believer. Thus, it was NOW time for God to reveal the Secret Administration with His Absolute Grace

A tool to have in our spiritual toolbox is that we need always to remember: When studying Scripture, the precept of "if God be willing" should always be understood, for indeed it is always present in God's

Word, whether **explicitly** or **implicitly**.¹⁴

The nation of Israel did NOT repent, they did NOT believe that Jesus was Israel's promised Messiah. Even so, we know that there will be a national restoration and blessing of Israel – yet NOT because of Romans 11:25, but according to the terms of the New Covenant.¹⁵

When God enacts the New Covenant there is NO cause, NO need for Israel to be provoked to jealousy, as the whole nation will be BORN in "ONE DAY"!¹⁶

Yes! "ALL Israel" shall be saved, because "the gifts and calling of God are without repentance," when GOD will be "eliminating their sins" (Romans 11:26-29).

To conclude, "UNTIL the complement of the nations may be entering" (Romans 11:25) sits within the aforementioned dispensational conditions where the One Body did NOT exist, and moreover could NOT exist, NOR was the ecclesia which is His Body even hinted at in that DISPENSATION.

Mars' Hill: A Study on Acts 17

Even among those who place a great emphasis on Paul, with his unique apostleship and message, there is an amazing neglect of one of his most outstanding messages found in the Book of Acts: his message given on Mars' Hill. The content of his message to this group of unbelieving pagans has been overlooked for far too long. These words of Paul contain a very rich message. Preserved in the Scriptures, we know that, not only was it a challenge to the pagans of Athens, but it will prove to be a challenge to the members of Christ's Body as well.
