An Illustration of "Rightly Dividing"

Study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, *rightly dividing* the Word of Truth (II Timothy 2:15).

Endeavor to present yourself to God qualified, an unashamed worker, **correctly partitioning** the Word of Truth (CV, 1930).

ightly dividing the Word of Truth" (II Timothy 2:15), or "correctly partitioning" is key to understanding Scripture. It is simply seeking to make a difference where God makes a difference. Such Scripture analysis requires one to be a dedicated "workman" to search out divine distinctions. Similarity implies differences, and while there are many similari-

ties between certain things in Scripture, things that are similar are not the same.

Consider with me an illustration of "rightly dividing" or "correctly partitioning." Let me ask you a trivia question:

What highway runs north to south through the eastern coastal states of the United States, from Maine to Florida?

The most common answer given is I-95. But if asked further, "Is there still another highway that meets this description?" Some will answer US-1. Of course, both answers are correct. The fact is that both I-95 and US-1 run north to south through the eastern coastal states of the United

States, from Maine to Florida.

Yet, while I-95 and US-1 have many similarities, to say that they are identical, or the same highway, would be to drastically overstate the case, and would be a serious error.

In some places these two highways share the

same pavement, so that they would appear to be the same highway.

However, in other places they are more than 100 miles apart (in Georgia and South Carolina).

Despite their many similarities, there are also many more distinctions between these two highways. For example I-95 and US-1 take turns being east and west of each other. Through much of

To say that someone lived right off of US-1, or that someone lived right off of I-95 could be as much of a difference as 100 miles east to west, and 165 miles north to south!



West, FL, while I-95 runs 1,908 miles from the Canadian border to Miami, FL. This is a 462-mile difference.



Paul's Priestly Ministry (A Compilation)

Prior to the revelation of the present *Secret Administration* found in Ephesians and Colossians, Paul's ministry was a *prophetic* light "to the Gentiles" (Acts 13:47) under the auspices of Israel (Isaiah 49:6), Paul himself "acting as a priest" (Romans 15:15-16, CV). During his earlier ministry, by his own admission, his teaching was limited to what "the prophets and Moses did say should come" (Acts 26:22), proclaiming "the hope of Israel" (Acts 28:20). This vital key is crucial to the proper understanding of the epistles which Paul wrote prior to Ephesians, letters which were "out of an installment" (I Corinthians 13:9-10, 12, CV).

This is a collection of eight important articles, by four authors: Vladimir Gelesnoff (1877-1921), A.E. Knoch (1874-1965), Adlai Loudy (1893-1984), and Clyde L. Pilkington, Jr.

To help us better understand Paul's ministry during the Acts and post-Acts period, it is important to understand that it involved three distinct stages, all of which were facilitated by Israel's rejection of truth.

The three progressive stages of Israel's apostasy in the book of Acts (13:46; 18:6; 28:26-28) correspond to the three stages of progression and advancement in Paul's ministry: Justification, (Re)conciliation, and the Secret Administration.

The first two stages were a result of *progressive revelation* – truth hidden in the Hebrew Scriptures; while the last and final stage – the Administration of the Secret – was the revelation of an *absolute secret* "*hidden from the ages IN GoD*" until it was made known in Ephesians and Colossians.

In 1909, Vladimir Gelesnoff (1877-1921) wrote astutely concerning these three stages of Paul's ministry:

Paul's ministry passed, as it were, in three stages, each based on a special revelation – each successive revelation coinciding with a new turn of Israel's apostasy.

- (1) The rejection of the Spirit in the land brought forth the gospel of God or Justification.
- (2) The hostility of the Dispersion disclosed the mystery of the gospel, or the secret news the Reconciliation.
- (3) The last thing revealed is a Secret Economy of transcendent favor, where physical distinctions have no place.

As Israel declines, those Israelites and Gentiles who attended Paul's ministry were lifted higher and higher. They *began* in the grace of justification; they *proceeded* in the peace of reconciliation; they *attained* a culmination, acme, and climax in the zenith glory of heavenly realms.

- ◆ *Justification* goes back to Abraham in uncircumcision.
- ♦ *Reconciliation* reverts [back] to Adam.
- ◆ *The Secret Economy* reaches [back] even beyond sin's entrance.

One after another the grim shadows of past ages are passed and left behind, and still their flight continues, onward and upward, to the source and cause of all: God Himself – and there undisturbed by physical distinctions, unaffrighted by a law inflexible, justified, reconciled, seated with Christ, complete in Him, we are left in the presence of our Father in the unalloyed enjoyment of His love.⁵


Endnotes

 Justification is not mere forgiveness, but rather, it means to be constituted or made righteous. "Forgiveness" is at the core of religious teaching and activity; and at the root of forgiveness is guilt. The followers of religion seek to obtain forgiveness through some means – concerted effort, confessions, prayers, penance, resolutions, etc. What Paul taught went well beyond that. The revelation given to him involved "justification" which, instead of being rooted in guilt, is rooted in "righteousness."

part. It was not God Who needed reconciliation to man, but man who needed reconciliation to God, and it was The Father "Himself" Who did the work through His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. This is an amazing revelation of truth committed to Paul, a revolutionary doctrine in contrast to record-keeping orthodoxy.

The enmity, division and estrangement of man toward God have been removed by the Father Himself. The far-reaching, triumphant work of Jesus Christ was not limited to those who currently believe. He was not partial in His work and accomplishments – He was all-inclusive. Christ did His wonderful work for the whole world. Therefore, this reconciliation is not man's work in any sense. Man is not restoring himself to God; man is not coming to God, but God is coming to man, in Christ: "that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself" (II Corinthians 5:18).

- 3. The present Secret Administration was "hid in God" (Ephesians 3:9), "hid from the ages and generations" (Colossians 1:25-26). It unveils "the unsearchable riches of Christ" (Ephesians 3:8) not found elsewhere in Scripture. It involves "The Dispensation of the Grace of God" (Ephesians 3:2), a despotism of grace, committed only to Paul, not associated with any covenant, new or old (Ephesians 2:14-15; Colossians 2:14), nor to human merit or rules (Colossians 2:8), ordinances, holy days, etc. (Colossians 2:16).

All things emphasized in the past under Israel's administrations (Promise, Law and Pentecost) have been removed. We now live under an administration where the Barrier Wall has been removed (cf. Ephesians 2:14, CV), and in the absence of that wall we are "complete in Him" (Colossians 2:10). There is nothing that needs to be added.

Believers of this present Secret Administration are a "Joint-Body" (Ephesians 3:6), called the "One New Man" (:15), and share Christ's Universal Headship inherent in the Heavens (4:15-16; Colossians 1:16-19; 2:10).

Because the current administration was an absolute secret, it is not the subject of prophecy. What this means is that Israel is currently in abeyance (Lo-ammi - "Not My People"), and her prophetic clock has now stopped, resulting in any timetable of prophecy being paused for the past two millennia.

Ephesians and Colossians are the present truth for the current dispensation. Ephesians introduces the Secret Administration in which we live, while Colossians, its companion epistle, completes the Word of God. There are no other Secret Administration letters beyond Ephesians and Colossians. 
